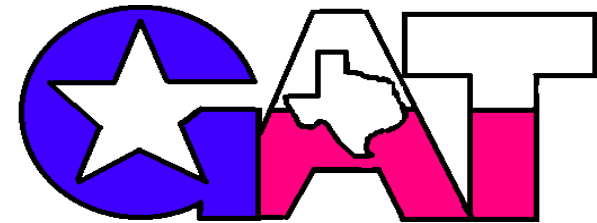

She dedicated herself to developing the athletic and character potential of every young athlete that came through her door, and was rewarded with the gratitude of generations of women, some of whom became professional athletes, performers, or coaches.

Jodie is a competitor, coached elite level athletes, and accumulated many artistic gymnastics competition titles, particularly in Floor Exercise. Her passion for excellence was evident in her enthusiastic coaching style, which led USGF judge Pat Etheridge to remark that Jodie’s sideline coaching was as remarkable as her routines. Jodie became a USGF judge also, and credits her mentors Jennifer Host, Carol Hillenburg, and Pat Etheridge in that role. Jodie has also been a GAT clinician for 14 years and has served on the GAT board.

For the past fifteen years, Jodie has served as the Head Coach and Choreographer for the Show Team of Houston at Biron Gymnastics. Jodie has led the Show Team to numerous National TeamGym titles and is recognized as an international level choreographer. Under her direction the Show Team has represented the USA Gymnastics in the past three World Gymnaestradas. In 2003, the Show Team was selected to perform in the most prestigious performance of the Gymnaestradas, the “FIG GALA”. In 2007, the team performed for standing room only crowds and received the highest accolades from the spectators as well as the international gymnastics officials. The Show Team has again been selected to perform in the “FIG GALA” at the 2011 World Gymnaestrada in Lausanne, Switzerland.

Jodie Trncak has influenced countless coaches and gymnasts with her expertise and deep passion for the sport. Her greatest pride is watching girls transform into disciplined, artistic, athletic, community-minded young women of strong character. Ms. Jodie, we are pleased to recognize you with our 2010 Honorary Life Member Award!

LIFE MEMBER AWARD

The Life Member Award is presented to the person(s) who have given a long period of outstanding service and accomplishment to the sport of gymnastics in Texas.

2010 LIFE MEMBER AWARD:

JODIE TRNCAK

We are very pleased to honor Mrs. Jodie Trncak as an Honorary Life Member for her accomplishments in gymnastics. For 38 years Jodie has created and led gymnastic programs, including internationally recognized performance teams. Her contributions are wide-ranging, but they all emanate from a true passion for mentoring young gymnasts; a passion which Jodie attributes to her mother, who was a Hall of Fame legend in Fast Pitch Softball.

Jodie applied her Bachelor of Arts in Teaching (with a minor in Art) in building a gymnastics program for the Ft. Bend School district in 1972, where she taught for 5 years. It was there that she recognized her calling to gymnastics and became a coach to Katy Kips and Gizi's, then finally at Biron's Gymnastics where she has been for more than 25 years.

In 2003 she took the chance to start an Acrobatic Gymnastics program, a very successful program ... producing 2 Silver Medalists from the World Championships, 2 Gold Medalists at the Visa Championships and numerous National Team members. Lorna is the Acrobatic Gymnastics Texas State Director, a judge for Acrobatics, and has brought four international level coaches from Bulgaria to start teams here in Texas and in Louisiana.

Not all kids are gymnasts so to draw them into the gym, the Boerne Gym offers other programs. Each summer they give kids a chance to develop their bodies and minds in a team sport unlike any other. The Circus Arts program holds camps, identifies skills that each attendee possesses, and fits them and their needed skill into making a circus work. The Boerne Gym gives scholarships so children's organizations can attend the summer camp. The kids get a chance to work out in a unique way and find their individual talents.

Lorna has been involved in gymnastics all her life, from standing on her father's shoulders at age three to learning the business side. This has helped her create opportunities for more people to participate in this great sport. She has been a member of GAT for a long time ... even has a badge from the 1989 Convention! At that convention she met Dr. Darlene Schmidt who helped her start a developmental pre-school program for kids with disabilities. She exemplifies what GAT is all about. Lorna says, "Thanks for your organization and all you do for gymnastics and the youth of Texas." We welcome you, Lorna as an Honorary Life Member of GAT. Elected 2010.

AWARD

The Life Member Award is presented to the person(s) who have given a long period of outstanding service and accomplishment to the sport of gymnastics in Texas.

2010 LIFE MEMBER AWARD:

LORNA SPELLMAN

Interest in gymnastics started when Lorna was quite young. Her father, who is her inspiration in life, was a gymnast ... he always taught her fun tricks. He coached at Bemidji State College with, among others, Larry Griswald who worked with George Nissan to invent the trampoline. The seed for teaching and coaching was planted during college, but after a short stint there, she left school to travel with Ringling Brothers/Barnum & Bailey Circus. There she performed a 35 foot high dive, did aerial work, and rode the elephants.

She opened her first gymnastics school in Morgan City, Louisiana before retiring to Boerne to raise her family. It wasn't long before she found herself coaching again. Those few classes soon developed in Fantastic Gymnastics and in 1991, a new permanent facility was built and the name was changed to Boerne Gymnastics Center. Her greatest joy is to have former students come in to sign up their children for classes, desiring for them the benefits they gained from the sport.

2010 HONOR AWARD:

WILLIAM "BILL" SCHMIDT

William T. "Bill" Schmidt, 78, of San Marcos, passed away on Saturday, July 3, 2010 peacefully at his home with his family present. He was born April 10, 1932 in Evanston, Ill. to William Authur and Julia (Theisen) Schmidt.

Bill graduated from New Trier High School in Winnetka, Ill. in 1951. He served in U.S. Army as a corporal in 1954. In 1958 he graduated with a Bachelor of Science Degree from Western Illinois and in 1959 with a Master's Degree from Eastern New Mexico University in Portales, N.M.

He began his teaching career in Carlsbad, N.M. from 1959 to 1968 and moved to San Marcos where he continued his teaching at Seguin High School from 1968-1969 and later at Lamar Middle School in San Marcos from 1969 to 1974. Bill then went into sales from 1974 to 1976 beginning with Wilson Sporting Goods in Iowa City, Iowa and Gibson's Department Store in San Marcos. He retired from his own business of Terrier II Electronics in 1983.

In 1978 Rich accepted the position as Head Coach for the University of Texas El Paso's Gymnastics Program. During his 5 years coaching at UTEP, Rich completed his Bachelors Degree in Civil Engineering.

During the summer of 1983, Rich and Marilyn worked as master staff for Karolyi's Gymnastics camp and married shortly after. In 1984 they opened Trevino's Gymnastics School. Rich is credited with having the first Acrobatic Gymnastics Team in Texas which was coached by Alex Douglas. Rich has also produced multiple gymnasts who have received gymnastics scholarships to colleges and universities including Iowa, Denver, University of Oklahoma, Missouri, and Centenary College.

JAMES JEFFERS

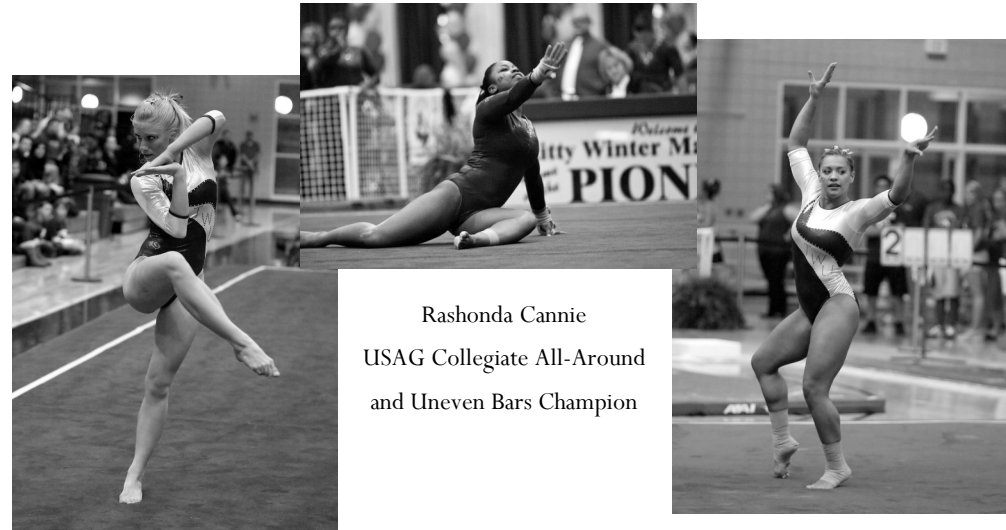

2010 SERVICE TO YOUTH AWARD:

JUDY CLINE

Judy Wills Cline is a JO-time World Champion in trampoline, synchronized trampoline and tumbling. She was the first World Champion in each of those events. She is in the Guinness Book of World Records for holding the most world titles and holds the record for the most individual titles in trampoline.(5) She holds tumbling records for bounding whips (26), bounding fulls (16); and bounding double-fulls (8), all accomplished on a non-sprung floor. She is known for her standing double-fulls and triple fulls in both directions. She won 38 National Titles in the events of trampoline, tumbling, vault and floor; 14 are NCAA National Titles. She is in the USA Gymnastics Hall of Fame and the Southern Illinois University Hall of Fame. She is the only person in history to win the World Championships in both trampoline and tumbling. Judy exhibited tumbling during the 1960 Olympics in Rome and toured the world with the Soviet Union's Olympic team.

As a coach in trampoline she has coached National Champions and 7 World Age Group Champions.. She has been the US coach to several World Championships and World Cup Competitions in both Trampoline and Tumbling. She was the National Coaching Coordinator for the Trampoline and Tumbling Program 1998 thru 2000. As a coach in gymnastics she has been on the National Coaching Staff for the TOP's program and the elite program. She has coached 22 athletes to NCAA gymnastic scholarships.

Judy has served GAT as a clinician for many, many years. She has been truly loyal to all the Texas athletes. For this, we honor and present Judy Wills Cline with our Service to Youth award.

SERVICE TO YOUTH AWARD

The Service to Youth Award is presented to the person(s) who does not serve as a gymnastics coach or program director. Their service is for a significant period of years, touching the lives of many children.

VICKI BOUNDS

Vicki has been involved with GAT since her daughter was on the competitive team at Capital Gymnastics ... that was in 1991 at the age of seven. Even though her daughter retired from gymnastics at the age of 12, Vicki has continued her involvement with GAT. She became involved first as a parent volunteer, and then was asked to be the Registration Coordinator. After serving in that position for six years, she was asked to be the Convention Coordinator and is still serving in that position. When Vicki is not working for GAT she is a high school teacher and travels, especially to Colorado to see her four grandchildren.

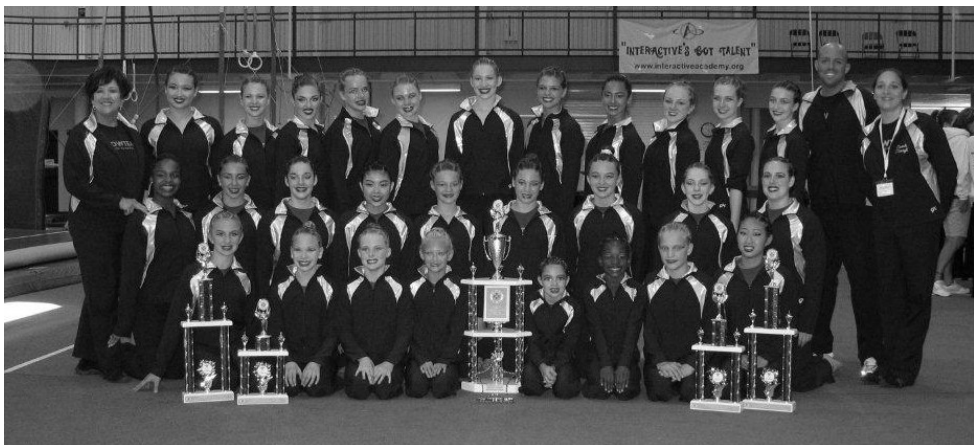
